CAM'S LEADERSHIP & ELECTION PROCESS

Leadership of CAM is provided by a five member Executive Committee (President, President-Elect, Vice President, Clerk, and Treasurer) and a twenty member Board of Directors. One-half of the Executive Committee and Board of Director positions are open for nomination and election each year, thus assuring both continuity and the opportunity for new leadership.

ALL positions are filled through open nominations and election by the membership.
